- John uses the above information to complete Swarthmore's Taxable Scholarship Worksheet and determines his taxable scholarship to be \$10,500 (see page XX)
- John completes the 2013 federal tax return (Form 1040EZ) and notes his scholarship on line 1, along with the sum of his earnings and scholarship (see page XXX). He determines he owes \$736.20 in taxes.
- Next he completes a "dummy" tax return, omitting his taxable need based scholarship (subtotal 3 from worksheet). Without the scholarship, he would have been due a \$51.80 refund.
- John contacts the tax desk to request a check for \$736.20 to be paid to the IRS and to have Student Accounts credit his account with the \$51.80, which he would have received from the IRS if he didn't have taxable scholarship.
