KEY:

<p>Type 1</p> 	<p>Separate hard lumps like nuts (hard to pass)</p>
<p>Type 2</p> 	<p>Sausage-shaped but lumpy</p>
<p>Type 3</p> 	<p>Like a sausage but with cracks on its surface</p>
<p>Type 4</p> 	<p>Like a sausage or snake, smooth and soft</p>
<p>Type 5</p> 	<p>Soft blobs with clear-cut edges (passed easily), formed</p>
<p>Type 6</p> 	<p>Fluffy pieces with ragged edges, mushy stool, semi liquid</p>
<p>Type 7</p> 	<p>Watery, no solid pieces - entirely liquid</p>

DEFINITION OF DIARRHOEA

Abnormally frequent watery stools - type 7 or 6

**DO NOT SEND STOOL SPECIMENS FOLLOWING
ADMINISTRATION OF LAXATIVES OR ENEMAS**

DO NOT SEND SPECIMEN UNTIL THIRD
EPISODE OF DIARRHOEA IN 24 HOURS
